



### SPHC MITE Fee Agreement

1. I understand the placement fee of \$200 is only refundable prior to placements.
2. I understand that my MITE registration includes the SPHC "Summer Skills and Development" sessions April-July and the 2025-2026 Regular Season.
3. I understand that upon registration my player is agreeing to commit to the future placement on a SPHC MITE team for the 2025-26 hockey season and that the commitment fee of \$465 will be applied to my season fee.
4. I understand that monthly payments of \$138.33 will be automatically charged, beginning on July 1, 2024, and continuing August 1, 2025, September 1, 2025, October 1, 2025, November 1, 2025, and ending December 1, 2025 for a total of 6 installment payments.
5. I understand that if my player vacates the roster spot on or before April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, I will obtain a FULL REFUND of my commitment fee of \$465 and my MITE PLACEMENT fee of \$200.
6. I understand that if my player vacates the roster spot between April 2<sup>nd</sup> and MITE PLACEMENTS my \$465 commitment fee and any captured monthly installments \$138.33 (July) will NOT be refunded. I will ONLY receive a refund of the MITE PLACEMENT fee of \$200.
7. I understand that if my player vacates the roster AFTER MITE PLACEMENTS, I will forfeit my commitment fee of \$465 AND my MITE PLACEMENT fee of \$200 including any captured monthly installments.
8. I understand that if my player vacates the roster spot on or after October 1, 2025, I owe the SPHC the entire season fee of \$1495.
9. I understand that I have the option to decline, in writing, the roster placement my player is offered within 48 hours of the placement offer being posted (offer period). The captured August payment (\$138.33) will be refunded if a decline is received, in writing, within 48 hours of position offer posting. Declines received after the 48-hour offer period will result in forfeiture of the August fees.

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In conjunction with the standard fees including the general fee, placement fee, and commitment fee, players may be required to contribute to a supplementary slush fund. This fund is intended to cover expenses related to tournaments, showcases, and associated team fees, which can vary between \$300 and \$800 depending on the age level and the number of scheduled events.

These additional fees are essential to sustain the team's operational costs and ensure participation in various competitive events. They are calculated based on the specific needs and commitments associated with each team's competitive program.
